**MEMORIAL DAY IS A TIME TO PAUSE FOR A MINUTE OF
RESPECTFUL SILENCE IN MEMORY OF THOSE WHO HAVE DIED
IN THE SERVICE OF OUR NATION**

Most Americans, especially those who served in the armed forces, are well aware of the difference between Veterans' Day (Nov. 11) and Memorial Day, which falls on the last Monday in May. On Veterans' Day, the nation recognizes all those who served in the military. Memorial Day is the more solemn occasion – a day when we pause to reflect upon the sacrifice of those who died in the service of their country.

It is an American axiom that the United States is a peaceable nation, but even a pacific-minded republic finds itself forced into conflicts. We did not invite the British invasion at the heart of the War of 1812 in which more than 2,000 American fighting men fell. Nor were we the aggressor as events in Europe dragged us into World War I, which took the lives of more than 53,000 doughboys, and the World War II (battle deaths 291,000, and deaths from other causes, 113,000).

When not compelled to fight for our own survival, the men who fell gave their lives in defense of essential American ideals such as freedom, democracy and opposition to tyranny.

The bloodiest war in U.S. history, of course, was the Civil War, in which half a million men, northern and southern, Union and Confederate, failed to return from an epic struggle for American unity under an emancipationist regime.
